



#### **MEANING FLOWS FROM ORIGIN**

### ROLE DISTINCTION

→ Rooted in Genesis (Creation Order)

A woman's submissive role is based on Adam being formed before Eve.

1 Cor. 14:34-35; 1 Tim. 2:11-13

#### **MODESTY**

→ Rooted in Genesis (Covering of Shame)

Modest dress is based on God's covering of Adam and Eve

Gen. 3:7, 21; 1 Tim. 2:9-10

### 1 TIMOTHY 2:9-15

σωφροσύνη (so-fros-SOO-nay)

- Women are to dress "with propriety and moderation" (sóphrosýné) —VERSE 9
- They are to continue "in faith, love, and holiness, with self-control" (sóphrosýné again) —VERSE 15

True modesty flows from a heart aligned with God's original design.



# God's Solution VERSUS Man's

Man's Response to Sin – Loincloths (Gen. 3:7-10)


Result: Adam and Eve hid from God's presence out of fear and shame, revealing human inadequacy in addressing sin.



# God's Solution VERSUS Man's

God's Provision – Tunics (Gen. 3:21)

In Genesis 3:21, God made tunics of skin for Adam and Eve, identifying the *region of shame*, symbolizing His provision, and underscoring the need for a sacrificial covering for sin.




### Genesis 3 and the BASELINE

#### Isaiah 64:

6 But we are all like an unclean *thing*, And all our righteousnesses *are* like filthy rags; We all fade as a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, Have taken us away.
